Reading	Making Inferences
Writing	Writing pour quoi stories
Math	Addition and subtraction with regrouping
Daily Language Instruction	Pluralization rules: adding -s; adding -es when a word ends in a <i>sh</i> , <i>ch</i> , <i>s</i> , or <i>x</i> ; changing the <i>y</i> to an <i>i</i> and adding -es; and irregular plurals
Spelling	When an <i>e</i> , <i>i</i> , or <i>y</i> follows the /j/ sound, the /j/ is sometimes spelled with the letter <i>g</i> . When /j/ is at the end of a word, it is spelled <i>-ge</i> or <i>-dge</i> .
Social Studies	Understanding how people of different ages, cultural backgrounds, and traditions contribute to their community and how citizens respect these differences (China)
